LOCAL RULES

- 1. OUT OF BOUNDS Rule 18.2
- Beyond any hedge bordering the course or boundary fence. In the river bordering the North side of the course.

- On or beyond any line of white stakes or white line defining the boundary of the course.
- On or beyond the path to the left of the 10th hole.
- 2. PENALTY AREAS Rule 17

All lakes and ditches on the course. Yellow or red stakes denote Penalty Areas.

- 3. ABNORMAL COURSE CONDITIONS Rule 16

a. Immovable Obstructions include:

Bollards on the 1st hole, public footpaths and all designated made up paths, pipe crossing the river on the 12th hole, all fences on the course other than boundary fences.

- c. No Play Zones

Relief MUST be taken under Rule 16.1f.

Areas of Ground Under Repair marked with blue.

4. PROTECTION OF YOUNG TREES

The young or newly planted trees identified by stakes and/or plastic wrapping are "No Play Zones".

If a player's ball lies anywhere on the course other than in a Penalty Area and it lies in or touches such a tree or the tree interferes with the player's stance or area of intended swing the player MUST take relief under Rule 16.1f.

- 5. PROHIBITING PLAY FROM THE FRINGE OF A WRONG GREEN Rule 13.1 When taking wrong green relief on all holes except the 9th and 18th which is one green, the wrong green is defined to include the area of fringe grass around the putting green. This means when taking relief under Rule 13, the nearest point of complete relief must avoid interference from this area in addition to the wrong green.
- 6. BALL DEFLECTED BY POWER LINE OR SUPPORTING POLE
 If it is known or virtually certain that a player's ball hit a power line or supporting pole during the play of the 12th hole, the stroke does not count. The player MUST play a ball without penalty from where the previous stroke was made.

Unless otherwise specified within the Rules of Golf, the Penalty for a Breach of a Local Rule is: General Penalty: Stroke Play - Two Strokes; Match Play - Loss of Hole.
